AGRICULTURE SKILLS NEEDS: CERTIFICATE III IN RURAL OPERATIONS

Background

In 2015/2016 the Queensland Rural Jobs and Skills Alliance (RJSA) sought data to determine the Queensland agriculture industry's skills demand. Colmar Brunton was commissioned to undertake market research and conducted 993 telephone surveys across a number of industry groups, including Production Horticulture; Beef industry, Cotton, Grain and Feed, Intensive Livestock (poultry, dairy, pigs), Nursery and Garden, and Sugar Cane. The responses below are based on the survey feedback. While not linked to any particular qualification or specific agriculture sector it does provide an insight into the skills desired by the agriculture sector in general.

1. Industry's top business needs

Industry was asked if there were any particular skills missing in their workforce. 22% of survey respondents reported some form of skills shortage. Machinery or mechanical skills (including maintenance, welding and fabrication), information technology, computer skills, truck/forklift/tractor driving skills and manager/supervisor skills were all on the top of the list.

The top skill needs Queensland wide, other than previous experience and a good work ethic were:

- Machinery skills including maintenance / welding / fabricator
- IT / computer literacy
- Driving skills including truck / forklift / tractors
- Managerial / supervisory skills
- Appropriate licences

2. Preferred units in Certificate 3 in Rural Operations <u>AHC32816</u>

Anecdotal evidence that has been gathered over a number of years indicates that the following units are preferable. Note that there are many units that are relevant but these are the most preferred units. While each region has common skill needs, the desired units will vary even within sectors.

Welding is also a highly regarded skill as many farmers prefer to employ somebody who is multi-skilled and can do other tasks such as welding and machinery maintenance during the off peak season.

Units that may grow in demand is <u>AHCMOM311</u> Operate precision control technology and <u>AHCBUS301</u> hand held e-business tools.
