




Connect with agricultural job seekers

Linking farmers with interested, 'farm-ready' job seekers!



The Queensland Farmers' Federation, the Rural Jobs and Skills Alliance and Growcom are working with FarmReady Hub to create Queensland's very own industry-endorsed and government backed website that:

- 1 Educates people** about the diversity of agriculture – linking them to our commodities, employment, and training options. They are issued the digital FarmReady Card micro-credential.
- 2 Saves employers up to 70%** of their induction time by preparing job seekers for their first day of work so they can 'hit the ground running' on farm.
- 3 Organise** job seeker's employment signups (TFN, Super etc).
- 4 Freely links** farmers and employers to interested job seekers.
- 5 Freely email employers** their job start paperwork - including farmers, LHPs, and job agencies.

- New workers can email resumes, letter of offers and a job start kit, reducing paperwork - regardless of whether the farm is registered or not.
- Workers can show their FarmReady Card credential on their phone or in their resume, so you know they are coming prepared and giving you peace of mind that they have completed the training.
- FarmReady can promote your employment channels exclusively to FarmReady Cardholders, putting you front and centre amongst people who are keen to work in agriculture and ready to apply for work.

More about FarmReady

FarmReady's ethos is to look after farmers too, that's why we also offer other free optional services. Keep your eye out for job seekers who have a FarmReady Card, as they can freely email to you:

- **An electronic resume**
- **A letter of offer**
- **A Job Start Kit** (employee agreement/contract): This is handy if you currently receive your new employee's job start information via handwritten forms which can be hard to read, lack information and is time-consuming on the first morning.

To receive these emails, you don't need to do anything. A FarmReady Cardholder will ask you for your email address and mobile phone number. A code will be texted to your mobile phone, which will allow you to unlock the encrypted email for the purpose of keeping an employee's personal details safe.

Good and successful employees must arrive for work, adequately prepared and with a basic level of understanding. Providing a foundation for further training: onsite inductions (reduce by up to 70%), workplace training or formal education. This foundational knowledge allows an individual to absorb additional training better. So they are more likely to be self-sufficient and self-reliant.

For people to be genuinely 'farm-ready' they need a basic level of understanding about the industry, regional living as well as the job itself.

FarmReady is a twelve-month subscription for job seekers, so they are kept organised and trained for their membership duration. Tracking their history as they transfer around farms and keeping them up to date with industry changes or essential broadcasts.

Get listed in the Employer Directory within your region of the FarmReadyHub.

- a. Fill out the online application form: farmreadyhub.com/industry

Start connecting with workers – it can happen two ways:

- a. Ask your current staff and your new staff if they have a FarmReady Card. If not, send them to the website to complete the training.
- b. FarmReady Cardholders will contact you via your listing in the employer directory.

3

Receive a resume, letter of offer or Job Start Kit free of charge:

- a. The job seeker will ask you for your email and will email these documents as required.
