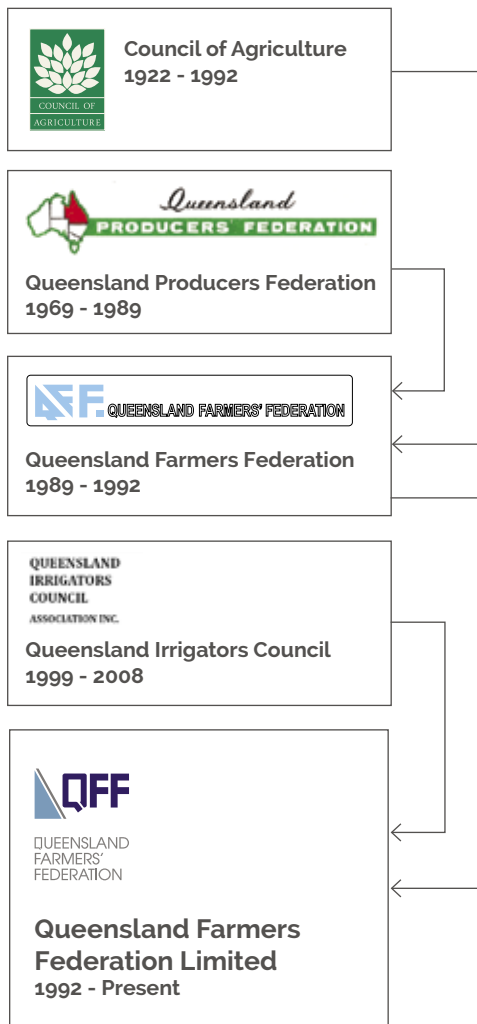
## WHAT WE DO
